

The film explores themes of ecology, family, and labor using magical realism as a narrative device to create dark, ethereal worlds that offer a glimpse into the power of the physical realm over our collective psyche.

The Duel

Canada // Short // Dance // 3 min. Go is a strategic two-player board game, known as "Yi"(弈) in ancient China, and "Go" in the west. "The Duel " is about the protagonist's inner struggle for victory and finding the meaning of opponents in her life. It is lonely for a skillful person without opponents. Through the battle of Go, the protagonist imagines a non-existent opponent and wants to have a duel. A real duel is to find a well-matched opponent who complements each other in fight and esteem. Most people treat their opponents with hostility. In fact, oftentimes it is not our family and friends who motivate us to persevere and reach the realm of success in the end. It is our survival and competition through rivalry. The choreographer intends to awe her opponents in life through this dance film.

A Feast That Never Comes

US // Short // Dance // 16 min. Four characters inhabit cycles within cycles of contentment, discontentment, inertia, movement, desire, and betrayal. A story emerges—told through the marriage of music (Ex-Fiancée) and dance (ChrisMastersDance) — functioning as a set of nesting dolls, inviting you to uncover as many layers as you wish. Directed by Maria Juranic.

ODD

ODD is a moment in which humans explore their inner capacities to find fulfillment in their external range in unforeseen otherworldly dimensions. To unobscure and bring to light possibilities that the human eye has not envisioned out of darkness.

The Spaces Within

US // Short // Dance // 6 min. The Spaces Within is a dance-for-camera work in which contemporary dance movements are intertwined with an ancient traditional movement form, in a quest to find universal elements within each. The site-specific choreography embodies the Yi Jin Jing movement form while responding to it from a contemporary perspective, creating a visual poem with dancers solidly rooted in the ground while embracing emptiness, a yin and yang of holding firm and opening up.

When a guest is enthusiastically welcomed into her hosts' immaculate home, she is inspired to reciprocate with an unexpected introduction to her own world. The result is a surreal and often absurd navigation through familiarity and estrangement, observed through mannerisms and habits, which serve as a metaphor for the fabric connecting and dividing individuals. GUEST is a short film that mixes genres, blending dance, absurd comedy and drama with the inclusion of dialogue in the native languages of the cast.


Craft beer generates tens of billions of dollars annually for the US economy. Despite beer's Egyptian and African heritage, these traditions have been mostly forgotten

The Other Ones

US // Short // Documentary // 11 min. Jimmy James came to the Esperanza Community after googling "Texas homeless camps." He had been living on the streets of Houston for about three years, and he arrived in Austin to find an encampment of roughly 150 people living in tents and temporary shelters on a sprawling, flat slab of asphalt off U.S. 183

The site had once been a Texas Department of Transportation storage lot. The state's governor, Greg Abbott, designated the site for camping in late 2019 in an effort to divert unhoused people from downtown Austin. The Other Ones Foundation (TOOF) came to the camp in the summer of 2020 to work in partnership with the residents and other organizations to create a safe community where people could access crucial support services.

As a result of this collaboration, the encampment evolved into the Esperanza Community, named through popular vote by the people living there, and guided by a similarly elected leadership committee of residents.

The Other Ones

"I think this is going to prove to be a model of a safe and dignified place where people can get out of the streets and work through the system to find housing," said Max Moscoe, TOOF's communications manager.

That has already proven to be the case for many Esperanza residents, including Jimmy. After living at Esperanza Community for about nine months, he was able to move into permanent housing at Community First! Village.

After surviving the Syrian war and becoming a refugee, Jacir, now resettled into a rough neighborhood in Memphis, Tennessee, is in search of a new life. He finds himself alone, with no knowledge of the culture, and struggles with his poor English... far from the ideal new life he imagined. A strange new environment is the least of Jacir's problems when he befriends a cat, Morty, which belongs to his next-door neighbor, Meryl, an elderly Caucasian lady who is an opioid addicted shut-in and former blues singer.

Influenced by conservative talk shows, Meryl wants nothing to do with her new neighbor and makes it a point to give him the cold shoulder. Jacir embarks on a journey to win the affection of a new love interest, Nadia, while dealing with her overzealous dad Adam; and measuring a newfound friendship with an African American rapper named Jerome.

All the while, he must prove to Agent Simmons with I.C.E that his suspicions are unfounded.

Allen Otte and John Lane tour the country with their performance of The Innocents – a piece created to shine a spotlight on the growing problem of wrongful convictions in the United States. Using a variety of found-object and homemade instruments, electronic soundscapes, and spoken texts, the performer-composers endeavor to explore various aspects of the issues surrounding wrongful imprisonment and exoneration in the American criminal justice system: mistaken identity, incarceration, injustice, politics, psychology, and resilience. The film culminates with a performance attended by Anna Vasquez an exoneree, who spent 13 years in a Texas prison system for a crime which never happened.


