Project Description

Our goal is to rejuvenate and transform the underutilized space adjacent to the historic Texan Theater into a vibrant gathering place for residents of all ages. The Texan Yard Revitalization Project is a visionary initiative that seeks to rejuvenate the underutilized space adjacent to the historic Texan Theater in Kilgore, Texas. This ambitious project is driven by a deep understanding of the theater's historic relevance in Kilgore, dating back to its construction in 1934 during the oil boom era. The Texan Theater, designed in the iconic Art Deco architectural style of the 1920s and 1930s, played a central role in Kilgore's cultural landscape. It served as a gathering place for the community, hosting a myriad of events, including movies, live music performances, and theatrical productions. The Texan Theater is not just a structure; it is a living testament to Kilgore's rich heritage and cultural identity.

Exterior Painting: \$62,000

Adding to the beautification of downtown Kilgore while preserving historical integrity necessitates specific paint types, specialized techniques, or additional restoration work.

Playground and Construction Materials: \$30,000

Construction materials for a dedicated playground are a core component of this project, creating a safe and imaginative space for children to play and explore in the heart of our downtown area.

Adult Recreational Furniture and Amenities: \$11,500

The inclusion of comfortable furniture and amenities ensures that the space caters to diverse age groups, echoing the Texan Theater's role as a space for community gatherings.

Interactive Elements: \$8,500

Interactive elements include a bocce ball court, ping pong tables, and extra large chess and checkers sets which will infuse the space with a sense of playfulness, paying homage to the Texan Theater's history of entertaining residents of all ages.

Total Budget: \$112,000

Our funding strategy leverages a diverse range of sources to ensure the successful completion of the project and its long-term sustainability.

The City of Kilgore has pledged its support for the Texan Yard project, with the City Manager expressing a commitment to pursue the completion of the Texan Theater project. This support includes financial contributions, in-kind services, and assistance with obtaining necessary permits and approvals.

E4 Leadership Kilgore, a leadership development program hosted by the Kilgore Chamber of Commerce, selected the Texan Yard project after a highly competitive process as their class project, demonstrating a commitment to fundraising and implementing the project. We plan to leverage their network and resources to secure corporate sponsorships from local businesses and organizations interested in supporting the construction of the playground and other familyfriendly amenities.

The Crim family, esteemed members of the Kilgore community, have pledged to participate in funding the completion of the Texan Theater project, particularly focusing on the addition of a wing that will include ADA accessible bathrooms for the community to use when participating in activities in the Yard. Their generous financial contribution, along with other private donations, will help bridge the funding gap and cover unforeseen costs beyond the current scope of the project.

In addition, we are actively pursuing external funding opportunities through grant making organization which offers financial support to small towns like Kilgore for community projects. This grant aligns perfectly with the project's focus on building community and may provide a significant portion of the funding needed to complete the Texan Yard project.

Timeline











The Texan Yard Revitalization Project is a meticulously planned endeavor aimed at transforming an underutilized space into a vibrant community hub in the heart of Kilgore, Texas. Our project timeline reflects our commitment to efficiency, community engagement, and timely completion.

We will finalize project plans and designs through extensive consultation with stakeholders and community members, ensuring that our vision aligns with the needs and desires of the local population.

Summer 2024

July marks the beginning of construction work on the Texan Yard project, with a focus on site preparation and installation of essential infrastructure. Throughout August, we will continue construction activities while closely monitoring weather conditions to mitigate any potential impacts on our timeline. We anticipate the completion of remaining construction work and the finalization of amenities installation in September. This phase will see the Texan Yard project taking shape, ready to fulfill its purpose as a dynamic community space.

October 2024

In October, we plan to celebrate the grand opening of the Texan Yard during the City of Kilgore's Oktoberfest celebration, a significant event drawing thousands of attendees annually. This marks a pivotal moment as the Texan Yard becomes an integral part of Kilgore's cultural landscape.

Winter 2024

November brings another opportunity for community engagement, as we host a free event coinciding with the REEL East Texas Film Festival and the annual Lighting of the Derricks, both of which take place in the Texan Yard. These events showcase the project's versatility and its potential to serve as a gathering place for various cultural celebrations and activities. wWe will wrap up any remaining tasks, conduct final inspections, and submit grant reports in December, documenting the project's outcomes and impact on the community. This will mark the culmination of months of hard work and collaboration, as we celebrate the successful completion of the Texan Yard project and look forward to the positive changes it brings to Kilgore and its residents.

Impact



Nestled in <u>Downtown Kilgore</u>, affectionately known as the "City of Stars" due to its glittering oil derrick lights during the Christmas season, the Texan Yard holds immense potential to unite our diverse community, celebrating culture and providing a space for pure enjoyment. This revitalized area will cater to families, young adults, seniors, and visitors, fostering inclusivity and engagement for everyone.

Community Connection: Our community faces a significant challenge in the form of limited accessible spaces for social interaction, cultural engagement, and recreational activities. Kilgore, while rich in heritage and character, lacks a versatile communal area that can cater to the diverse needs of its residents across generations. This scarcity of gathering places impedes community bonding and the cultivation of a vibrant shared identity.

Cultural Enrichment: The revitalized area will serve as a vibrant canvas for cultural events, performances, and gatherings, honoring the Texan's history as a cultural beacon. We have previously collaborated with the renowned <u>Texas Shakespeare Festival</u> to host indoor performances and cultural events, enhancing the city's cultural and artistic offerings. The creation of an outdoor stage would allow us to expand these offerings to free, outdoor events on a community stage. A letter of support is attached.

Youth and Education: With a quarter of our population under 18, the Texan Yard's transformation carries special significance. It will become a vibrant hub for our youth to learn, play, and grow, nurturing their active involvement in our community from an early age. The space will become a dynamic hub for youth activities and learning, benefiting students from <u>Kilgore College</u> and the Kilgore Independent School District and nurturing the next generation, just as the Texan Theater has played a part in shaping Kilgore's cultural heritage.

Senior Well-Being: The project will provide older adults, which make up approximately 35% of our residents, with a haven for social interaction, outdoor leisure, and cultural engagement, ultimately enhancing their overall well-being and quality of life, much like the Texan Theater once provided entertainment for all ages.

Legacy and Tradition: The Texan Theater stands as one of Kilgore's oldest structures, with significant historical and architectural value. This project plays a crucial role in preserving our town's heritage by rejuvenating a space closely associated with the theater. This project is poised to leave a lasting legacy, promoting unity, vibrancy, and shared experiences within the Kilgore community, akin to the Texan Theater's historical significance.

The Texan Yard's sustainability beyond construction is fortified by three key pillars:

Board of Directors: A dedicated Board of Directors, comprising influential local community leaders, has adopted a strategic five-year fundraising plan to provide ongoing financial support to The Yard post-construction, ensuring its continued relevance in Kilgore.

Lease Agreement: The project enjoys the security of a long-term lease agreement between REEL and the City of Kilgore, ensuring REEL's continued management control over the space. This steadfast arrangement underscores our unwavering commitment to sustaining the project's momentum and positive impact on the Kilgore community, much like the Texan Theater's enduring presence. **Established Partnerships:** REEL has already partnered with local construction and design firms to complete previous projects such as a new HVAC system and abatement for the Texan theater. Chavez Fabrications and Fencing and East Texas Lumber, both located in Kilgore, have provided estimates for the efficient and high-quality implementation of the outdoor stage and recreational amenities. Modo Studios volunteered their time and resources to design the Texan Yard architectural plans which are included in the project proposal document. We have plans to use Johnson & Pace, a East Texas firm, to manage this project once funding is secured.

As part of our "shovel ready" plan for the Texan Yard Revitalization Project, we have outlined the following:



Johnson & Pace is set to oversee the execution of the project plan, coordinating with contractors, and ensuring timely completion of deliverables. We believe these partnerships will leverage local expertise and resources to ensure the successful implementation of the Texan Yard Revitalization Project, creating lasting benefits for the Kilgore community.

Built in 1931, it bears witness to the golden age of cinema, with autographs of renowned western movie stars etched in the sidewalks outside. Our vision is to transform The Texan into an aesthetically appealing and vibrant space that serves as a catalyst for downtown Kilgore's revitalization. By preserving its rich history and creating a thriving cultural hub, we aim to attract visitors and locals alike, breathing new life into the heart of our community.
